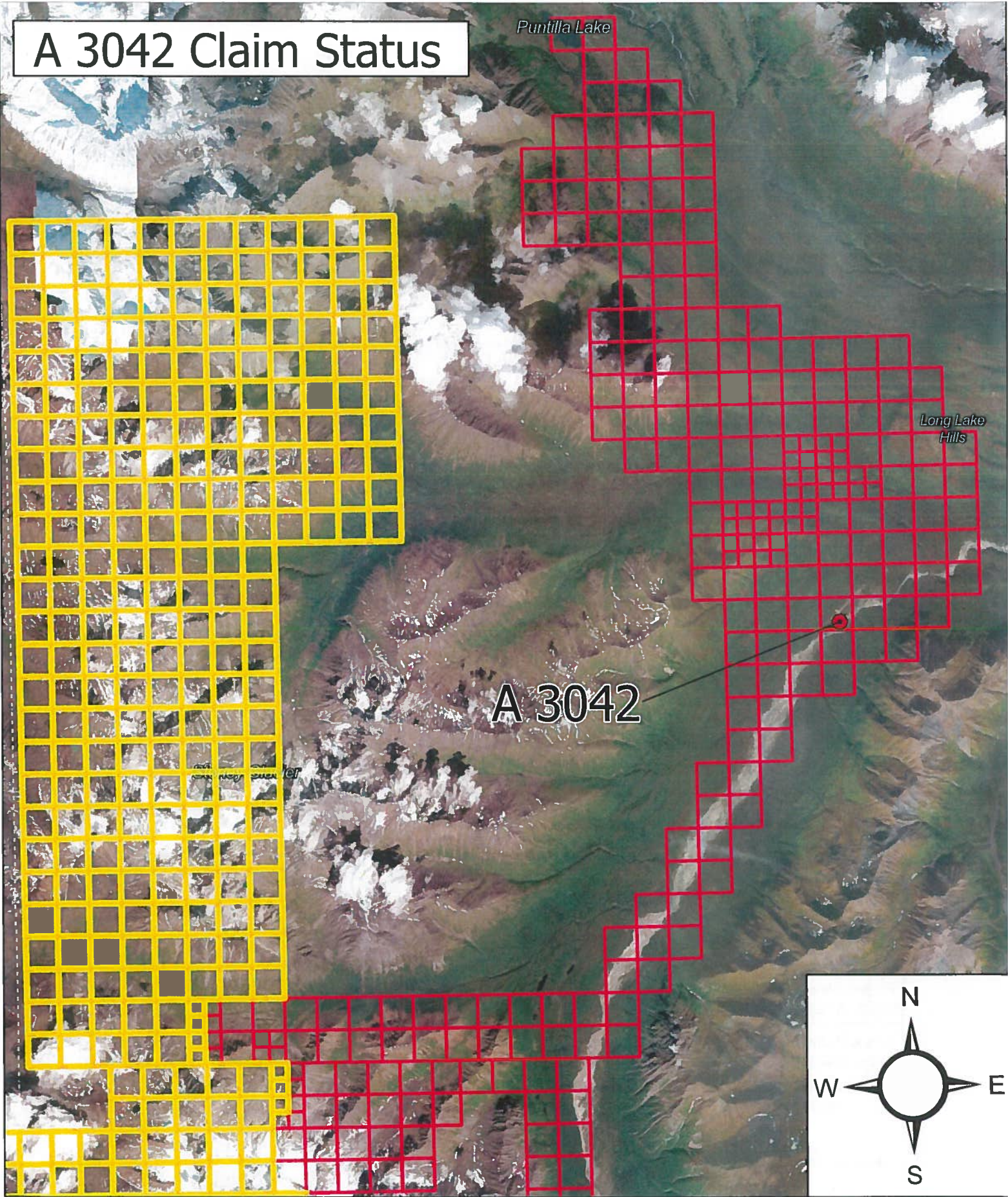

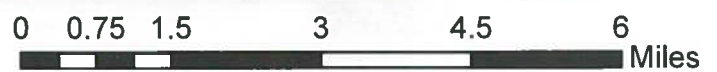

**Request for Winter Cross-Country Travel Authorization From Whiskey
Bravo Camp to the Mt Estelle Gold Project State Mining Claims**

Introduction

Nova Minerals Limited (Nova), an Australian public company entered into a joint venture with AKCM (AUST) Pty Ltd over the Estelle Gold Project state mining claims through its wholly owned subsidiary AK Custom Mining LLC (AKCM).

Ak Custom Mining LLC (Alaska Entity #10065576) is an Alaskan incorporated limited liability company and is there for qualified under AS 38.05.190 to acquire exploration and mining rights; and is authorized to conduct a mining related business under Alaska Business License #1058506.

Purpose

AKCM is submitting this document as an amendment to APMA #3042, and MLUP #3042 to request authorization for cross-country travel from the Whiskey Bravo exploration camp located on the south side of the Whiskey Bravo airstrip on the upper Skwentna River to the Mt Estelle Gold project state mining claims roughly 10 miles to the northwest of the Whiskey Bravo airstrip.

This request would be to support drilling operations and move equipment to the claim block after freeze-up in this region, usually beginning sometime in late October-early November. AKCM would like to move small equipment including mini-excavator, skid-steer and possible an small RC drilling rig/compressors to the claim block during this time to help in the construction of drill pads for exploration drilling.

Route

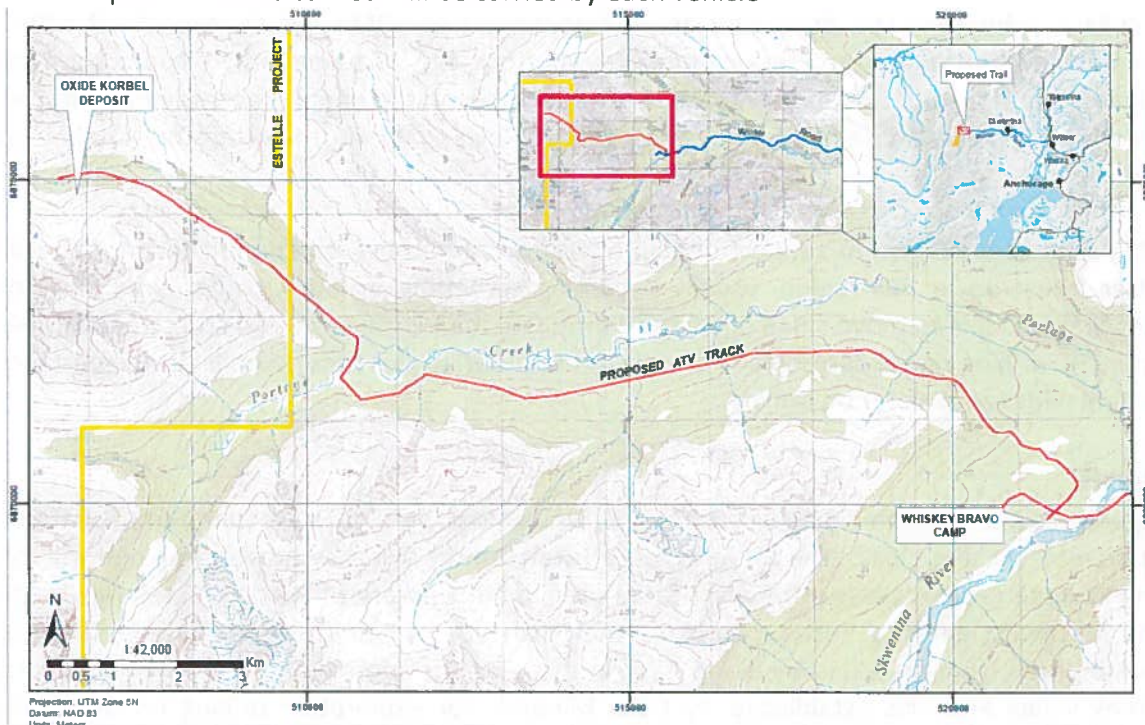
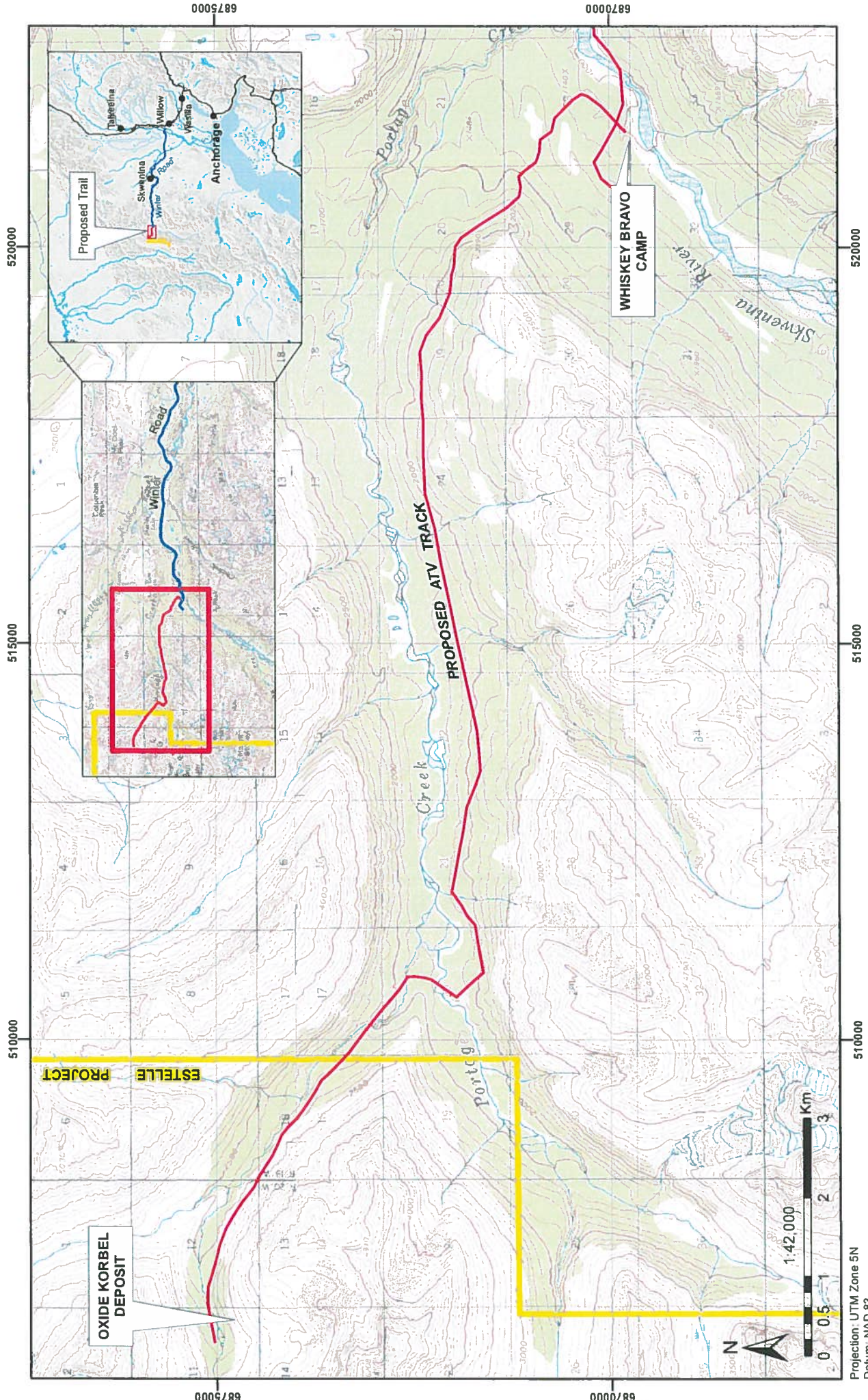


Figure 1. Proposed overland access track Whiskey Bravo camp to Korbel deposit

Figure 1 is a topographic map illustrating the route from whiskey Bravo camp to the Mt Estelle state mining claim block. The route proposed starts at the Whiskey Bravo camp and will follow the Portage Creek Valley to the west to an un-named tributary of Portage Creek flowing from the northwest entering Portage Creek on the north side of Portage Creek Valley. There is an existing trail from the Whiskey Bravo Airstrip that extends approximately 3.5 miles up Portage Creek valley and was established by Kiska Minerals for exploration drilling on the Whistler project. The proposed AKCM route will leave the Kiska Minerals trail near its end and travel

approximately 6 miles up Portage Creek to the Mt Estelle Gold Project state mining claim block boundary near the Oxide/Korbel prospect.

Equipment

Equipment to be moved will consist of the following:

Snow Cats

Track ATV / snow machines

1 skid-steer

1 mini excavator

1 small RC drill rig/compressors

Transportation of Hydrocarbons

The transportation of all hydrocarbon products will be in accordance with State of Alaska requirements and AKCM's safety requirements. Specifically:

- All vehicles transporting fuels and oils must be roadworthy and suitable for safe transport
- All drums and fuel containers will be properly secured to restrict movement
- Appropriate identification and safety signs will be properly displayed and fire equipment carried for the transportation of any bulk fuels
- Spill kits will be carried will be carried by each vehicle
